Hello Neighbor,

Even in the dog days of August, South Bend was humming with activity. We unveiled a sign noting us as a Silver Level Bike-Friendly City, marking South Bend one of the most bike-friendly cities in the Midwest. We're also well on our way to creating the 2019 Budget with the Common Council. Check southbendin.gov for budget meeting times and presentations from August and September.

Swing by the Rum Village Nature Center every Sunday at 2:00 p.m. through November 11 for family fun! Upcoming programs include Insect Discovery on September 23 and an Autumn Scavenger Hunt on October 3. The Martin Luther King, Jr. Recreation Center's after school program runs throughout the school year from 3:00 to 5:30 p.m., only \$5 per child per month with a \$10 registration fee. The Value of Water's "Imagine a Day Without Water" is Wednesday, October 10. Basic morning habits - brushing your teeth, showering, flushing the toilet, making coffee - all involve the use of water. Have you ever thought about where water goes to get cleaned before it comes from your faucet or where it goes after its used? It's important to recognize how vital water is to our daily lives and how our quality of life would be much different without it.

The official start date of the Fall ReLeaf program is Monday, October 29. City crews will collect leaves from neighborhoods in a systematic matter; however, if residents have leaves ready to collect prior to the start date, the City will take pickup requests starting October 15. To request a pickup, residents need to call 311. Once the Fall ReLeaf program begins, residents will not need to call to request a pickup. Leaves need to be free of trash and other debris or they may not be collected.

Our Division of Sewers would like to remind residents if they ever experience a sewer emergency or basement flooding to report it to 311 even if it is after hours or on a weekend. City standby crews are available after hours to assist in emergencies.

Landlord registration for 2019 runs through December 31. Anyone who owns a South Bend property they do not personally occupy and instead rent out for residential use should register every year with Code Enforcement. For more information, call 311 or go to southbendin.gov/landlord. There is no fee to register during this period.

Clerk's Corner


Greetings, South Bend!

Less exciting of course is how to handle the leaves accumulating in your yards. Here are some helpful steps from the Street Department to streamline the leaf collection process in October:

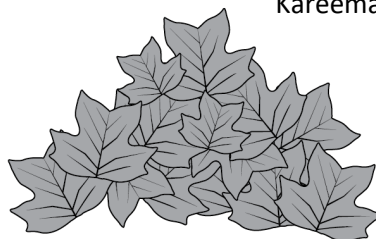
- Please rake leaves to the curb line but do not rake leaves into the street, as this will plug the street drains, which could cause flooding during rain.
- Avoid parking on top or in front of leaf piles along curb lines, as this hampers collection crews.
- Do not contaminate leaf piles with sticks, trash, or other debris. To prevent equipment damage, crews cannot collect such piles and property owners will be responsible for their disposal.
- Burning leaves is a violation of City ordinance (South Bend Municipal Code § 9-20).

During this beautiful and exciting season, thanks for doing your part to keep South Bend beautiful!
