South Bend Animal Care & Control would like to remind residents that outdoor pets should be brought inside during the cold winter months. Pets get cold, just like people!

The South Bend Fire Department reminds residents to practice candle safety this winter. Avoid using candles in bedrooms, bathrooms, and sleeping areas. Extinguish candles when you leave a room or the home or go to bed. Keep children and pets away from burning candles.

Solid Waste would like to remind residents to have City trash bins clear of snow on scheduled pickup days. City containers must be placed in front of snow banks and not be blocked by any vehicles. Please do not place City containers behind or on top of snow banks or up on sidewalks. Solid Waste will also be offering free Christmas tree disposal in from January 2 to January 31. Residents who have trash services provided by the City can schedule a pickup online at southbendin.gov/treepickup or can call 311.

Residents can also request a free extra pickup for yard waste or a large item by filling out the form at southbendin.gov/extrapickup or by calling 311. Each household is allowed one extra pickup, equal to one cubic yard in size, per month at no charge. Additional extra pickups for the month will be charged \$20 per cubic yard. The extra pickup takes place on the same day as trash pickup.
