Hello Neighbor,

I hope you and your family are doing well and have enjoyed the holiday season!

As I've said in previous letters, I encourage all who are eligible to consider full vaccination against COVID-19 to make celebrating the holidays with your family safer.

If you or someone you know is struggling to keep up with their utilities, the City's Utility Assistance Program can reduce monthly water and sewer bill for qualifying applicants. Those who qualify could see a reduction in their bill up to \$25.50 every month for a year.

Applicants must meet income guidelines, have a City of South bend utility account in their name and receive sewer service. To apply or learn more, visit www.southbendin.gov/uap.

The City's Lead Program is still open for applications to make lead safe repairs in your home at no cost to you. In homes built before 1980, deteriorating lead paint can cause health problems and hinder development in children, especially those younger than age 6.

The City's lead grants can pay for home repairs that help stop lead contamination. Families who meet income requirements can receive up to \$15,000 in repairs at no cost. Please call 311 and ask about the City's Lead Grants for more information or visit southbendin.gov/lead.

Greetings, South Bend!

As the mowing season ends, let us all be mindful of the grass and tall weeds ordinance that went into effect in 2015. The ordinance sets a nine inch (9") maximum height limit for tall grass and weeds on all lots. The same regulations apply to vacant/ abandoned lots.

But, if you notice a nearby vacant lot is neglected—feel free to be a good neighbor by mowing that property without fear of trespassing laws. (Good Samaritan Law -Indiana Code Section 34-30-26-5) You can also report tall grass by contacting 311 or Code Enforcement directly at 574-235-9486. Let's all contribute to keeping South Bend safe and beautiful.

Leaf pickup can be viewed in real-time via the Fall ReLeaf Live Tracker on the City's homepage at southbendin.gov. The online map shows the status of different zones and leaf pickup on individual streets. Residents can type in their address or zoom in to find their streets.
