As we've seen a surge in COVID-19 cases in our area, it's more important than ever to get fully vaccinated to protect you and your loved ones. The vaccine is our best chance to put this pandemic behind us and safely return to life as normal.

Booster shots are also recommended to stay ahead of the latest virus variants. To get a vaccine, please visit ourshot.in.gov or walk in at the St. Joseph County Health Department vaccine clinic in the lobby of the County-City Building on Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The City's Utility Assistance Program is available to help you or a loved one with monthly water and sewer bills for qualifying applicants. Those who qualify could see a reduction in their bill up to \$25.50 every month for a year.

Applicants must meet income guidelines, have a City of South Bend utility account in their name and receive sewer service. To apply or learn more, visit www.southbendin.gov/uap.

The Division of Solid Waste is offering free Christmas tree pickup during the month of January. This program is open to all city residents – homeowners or renters.

Requests can be submitted at southbendin.gov/treepickup or by calling 311. All ornaments, lights, tree stands, etc. must be removed prior to pickup as trees will be made into mulch and compost.

The Northern Indiana Solar Co-Op has extended its deadline for signups through the end of February. The nonprofit co-op is free to join and can help South Bend residents and business owners receive full retail-rate net metering benefits before that mechanism expires next year. 2022 will be the year of growth for all residents. Be sure to stay productive throughout the year whether that's by going to work, school, or even taking care of loved ones.

We hope you're keeping warm this winter! City Snow Removal crews will be working to keep our streets clear and safe. City Code Enforcement will also be busy making sure our sidewalks are clear and safe for pedestrians to navigate. Please be mindful that it is the responsibility of the owner or occupant of any premises bordering or touching any street to remove snow and ice from the sidewalk within 24 hours after it has fallen or accumulated (South Bend Municipal Code Section 18-7).

Snow removal citations are fined at fifteen dollars (\$15.00) or more for the first violation, and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) or more for each subsequent violation. Citations may be issued for each day that the failure to remove snow continues.
