DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS SPECIAL TRUCKING PERMIT REFERENCE GUIDE

Definitions

<u>Hazardous Material</u> is any item or agent (biological, chemical, radiological and/or physical), which has the potential to cause harm to humans, animals or the environment, either by itself or through interaction with other factors.

Oversize Vehicle is any vehicle that exceeds:

- a. Thirteen (13) feet six (6) inches in height, or
- b. Eight (8) feet six (6) inches in width, or
- c. Forty (40) feet in length for a single vehicle, or
- d. Sixty (60) feet in length for a two-vehicle combination, or
- e. Sixty-eight (68) feet for a truck-trailer or truck-wagon combination.

Overweight Vehicle is any vehicle that exceeds:

- a. Eighty thousand (80,000) pounds gross vehicle weight, or
- b. Twelve thousand (12,000) pounds on the steering axle, or
- c. Twenty thousand (20,000) pounds on a single axle, or
- d. Thirty-four thousand (34,000) pounds on a tandem axle, or
- e. Eight hundred (800) pounds per inch of rim width and subject to the axle weights above.

Superload Vehicle is any vehicle that exceeds:

- a. Fifteen (15) feet in height, or
- b. Sixteen (16) feet in width, or
- c. One hundred ten (110) feet in length, or
- d. One hundred twenty thousand (120,000) pounds gross vehicle weight.
