Hello Neighbor,

I hope that you and your family are enjoying the Spring weather!

The City's annual Spring ReLeaf Program will be offered on a call-in basis beginning April 10 through April 21. Residents can call 311 to request a leaf pickup during that time. Pickup will begin the week of April 17.

Yard waste season is officially underway! Residents help reduce yard waste contamination by only putting leaves, grass clippings, weeds, twigs and flowers in their bins. Items such as animal waste, dirt and rocks, food waste, household trash, lumber and large tree limbs, oils, liquids and other hazardous waste, plastic bags and recycling should NOT be placed in yard waste bins. Yard waste collected from residents is converted to mulch and compost, which is available free of charge, if self-loading, at Organic Resources, which is located at 4340 Trade Drive.

The South Bend Lead Protection Grant is currently available to eligible households. The grant covers up to \$20,000 in lead safe repairs at your home at no cost to you! Households must meet income guidelines and have young children living in or visiting the home. To learn more about the grant visit www.southbendin.gov/lead.

The South Bend Police Department and other community organizations are teaming up to host a Summer Food Drive. Donations of non-perishable food items, hygiene products, diapers and wipes can be dropped off at SBPD's lobby starting on Monday, April 3. until Saturday, May 6 from 8 am – 12pm, when they will be hosting a drive-thru donation event.

Michiana Crime Stoppers is hosting its Spring Shredding Event at the St. Joseph County Fairgrounds on Saturday, April 15 from 8 am – Noon. There is a \$20 minimum donation to shred, and all proceeds go toward supporting Michiana Crime Stoppers.

¡Espero que usted y su familia estén disfrutando del clima primaveral!

El programa Spring ReLeaf anual de la ciudad se ofrecerá por teléfono a partir del 10 de abril hasta el 21 de abril. Los residentes pueden llamar al 311 para solicitar una recolección de hojas durante ese tiempo. La recogida comenzará la semana del 17 de abril.

La temporada anual de desechos de jardín de la Ciudad comienza el lunes 3 de abril y se extenderá hasta fines de noviembre. El programa ofrece recolección semanal de desechos de jardín, como recortes de césped y hojas, por una tarifa de \$4.50 por mes durante la temporada. Se proporciona un contenedor de basura de jardín de 48 o 96 galones y la recolección se realiza el mismo día que la recolección de basura. Los residentes pueden inscribirse en el programa de desechos de jardín en southbendin.gov/yardwaste. Si ya tiene un contenedor de basura de jardín y recibió el servicio de basura de jardín el año pasado, no necesita inscribirse nuevamente en el programa.

La subvención de protección contra el plomo de South Bend está actualmente disponible para los hogares elegibles. ¡La subvención cubre hasta \$20,000 en reparaciones seguras con plomo en su hogar sin costo alguno para usted!
