Check your outside vents. High efficiency appliances like furnaces and hot water tanks, as well as dryers, will all typically vent out to the side of your house and not out the chimney.

We don't normally recommend this, but don't be afraid to reset your power vented HVAC equipment 12 times today. These high winds are causing a lot of nuisance pressure switch errors that will lock out your system until it is reset.

Obviously want to make sure that the vents/intakes are clear, but the blockages aren't causing as many issues as the direct wind is.

You can reset it by either using the switch at your furnace, or by using the circuit breaker.

A general contractor is a **construction manager employed by a client**, usually upon the advice of the project's architect or engineer. Responsible for the overall coordination of a project, general contractors may also act as building designer and foreman (a tradesman in charge of a crew).

A general contractor must first assess the project-specific documents (referred to as a bid, proposal, or tender documents). In the case of renovations, a **site visit** is required to get a better understanding of the project. Depending on the project delivery method, the contractor will submit a fixed price proposal or bid, cost-plus price or an estimate. The general contractor considers the cost of home office overhead, general conditions, materials, and equipment, as well as the cost of labor, to **provide the owner with a price for the project**.

Contract documents may include drawings, project manuals (including general, supplementary, or special conditions and specifications), and addendum or modifications issued prior to proposal/bidding and prepared by a design professional, such as an architect. The general contractor may be the construction manager or construction manager at high risk.












