FAQs

WHAT IMPROVEMENTS CAN I MAKE **WITH THIS PROGRAM?**

The program reimburses property owners for only replacement of concrete curbs, sidewalks and ADA ramps in the public right-of-way. Any costs for tree removal, irrigation equipment damaged during construction or required resodding are not included in the reimbursement from the City.

WHICH CONTRACTOR SHOULD I USE?

The City cannot recommend contractors for work. Contractors do, however, need to be bonded with the Department of Public Works. To check whether a contractor is licensed and bonded or to request a list, call 311.

CAN I STILL APPLY IF I'VE HAD WORK DONE OR STARTED ON MY CURB AND SIDEWALK?

Any work completed before the application is approved will not qualify for the reimbursement program.

TARGET AREAS

PROCESS

The City of South Bend's Curb & Sidewalk Reimbursement Program assists property owners in making needed repairs to curbs and sidewalks abutting their properties. Per Chapter 18, Article 3 of the South Bend Municipal Code, the maintenance and repair of curb and sidewalk is the responsibility of the abutting property owner.

APPLICATION

The 2023 Curb & Sidewalk program offers reimbursement for replacement of existing curbs, sidewalks and ADA ramps within city limits. Applications can be found at southbendin.gov/curbsidewalkprogram.

All work must be done by licensed contractors bonded with the City's Department of Public Works. An estimated reimbursement amount, based on the amount of curb and sidewalk work planned, will be given during the preapproval process. After construction is completed, a copy of the proof of payment along with the signed application must be submitted by November 10, 2023 to receive reimbursement. Final reimbursement will be determined by the total work completed and will not exceed the amount provided during the pre-approval process.

TARGET AREAS

For 2023, the City has selected three target areas based on income and conditions of sidewalks. Homeowners who live within these target areas will receive a higher reimbursement amount.







1. PROJECT ESTIMATE

Contact a licensed contractor for an estimate on curb and/or sidewalk repair work on your property.

2. APPLICATION

Visit southbendin.gov/curbsidewalkprogram to fill out an application and include the contractor's estimate with your submission. Email application and contractor's estimate to rowpermitsoffice@southbendin.gov.

3. PRE-APPROVAL

The City will complete a pre-construction inspection of the project and give pre-approval within five business days of receiving an application.

4. PERMITS

Instruct the contractor to get sidewalk construction and occupancy permits from the City's Engineering Office, by emailing **rowpermitsoffice@southbendin.gov** or calling 574.235.9254.

5. CONSTRUCTION

Once the contractor has completed the project and has been paid, email proof of payment (signed contractor invoice) along with a copy of the pre-approval application to **rowpermitsoffice@southbendin.gov** by November 10, 2023.

6. REIMBURSEMENT

The City completes post construction inspection at the property. Upon a successful inspection, a reimbursement check will be mailed within six weeks.
