## SIGN CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

### **NEW CONTRACTORS**

- Complete Contractor Pre-Licensing Registration form (see page 2)
- 2. Provide Original Surety Bond as follows:
  - Bond must have a bond number
  - Term of bond must be for a one (1) year period with a beginning date and ending date
  - Amount of bond must be \$5.000
  - Principal's name on bond must match name used on registration
  - Bond must name the City of South Bend/St. Joseph County as the obligee
  - Bond form must indicate SIGN CONTRACTOR
  - Original bond is required and must be signed
- 3. Provide Certificate of Liability Insurance as follows:
  - Certificate must name the City of South Bend/St. Joseph County as the Certificate Holder
  - Limits of Liability must be \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per occurrence, and \$50,000 per property  $\triangleright$
  - Certificate must show proof of Workers Compensation (see details on page 2)
- 4. Be properly registered with the State of Indiana, if applicable (https://inbiz.in.gov/BOS/Home/Index)
- 5. \$125 annual registration fee

#### **RENEWALS**

- 1. Complete Contractor Pre-Licensing Registration form (see page 2)
- 2. Provide Original Continuation Certificate of your Surety Bond

If your Registration has been expired for more than 1 (one) year, you will be required to provide the following:

- Current Continuation Certificate of your Surety Bond
- **ALL previous Continuation Certificates**
- ALL missed annual registration fees

We cannot have a lapse in Bond coverage

- 3. If providing a new bond instead of a Continuation Certificate, be sure to follow building contractor registration requirements for new bond (above)
- 4. Provide Certificate of Liability Insurance, following the guidelines above
- 5. Continue proper registration with the State of Indiana, if applicable (https://inbiz.in.gov/BOS/Home/Index)
- 6. \$125.00 annual registration fee
