Our Venues Parks & Arts department is bringing back Fusion Fest for its second year on Saturday, September 14 from 11am-8pm and Sunday, September 15 from 11am-5pm at Howard Park. The multicultural, two-day festival will be filled with food vendors, music, demonstrations, and artisans from every region of the world. We hope to see you there!

The Linden Avenue Farmer's Market is on its 4th year! The market features local food vendors, farmers, a live DJ, and other family-friendly interactive entertainment at the Charles Black Center at the corner of N Falcon and W Washington St on the third Saturday of every month through October from 10am-2pm. If you are interested in becoming a food vendor or farmer, please fill out an application and learn more by visiting southbendin.gov/food-security.

Unused and unneeded styrofoam, such as egg cartons, cups and blocks of styrofoam, is now being accepted at the Solid Waste District of St Joseph County's Household Hazardous Waste facility. Residents can drop off styrofoam at the 828 Kerr St. location, Monday through Friday between 8:30am and 4pm, and Saturdays from 8am-12pm. Household Hazardous Waste also accepts electronics of all kinds, batteries, mercury, pesticides/herbicides, tires, waste fuels, and more. The service is free for South Bend residents.

Help fight crime in your neighborhood by registering your security cameras with the Sync South Bend Camera Registry. The registry provides South Bend Police with a comprehensive directory of public-facing cameras across the city to assist officers and detectives with criminal investigations. Residuos domésticos peligrosos también acepta electrónicos de todo tipo, baterías, mercurio, pesticidas/herbicidas, llantas, combustibles residuales, y más. El servicio es gratis para los residentes de South Bend.

To qualify, you must have a South Bend utility account in your name, receive sewer

service from the City, and have a household income at or below 80% of the area median income.

Eligible households can receive up to \$25.50 off each monthly utility bill.
