The program helps homeowners, property owners and businesses within city limits cover the costs of repairing curbs, sidewalks and ADA curb ramps adjacent to their properties. To qualify, you must have a South Bend utility account in your name, receive sewer service from the City, and have a household income at or below 80% of the area

median income.

Eligible households can receive up to \$25.50 off each monthly utility bill.
