MOVING CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

NEW CONTRACTORS

- 1. Complete Contractor Pre-Licensing Registration form (see page 2)
- 2. Provide Certificate of Insurance stating the following:
 - **CITY Property:**
 - Naming the City of South Bend as co-insured
 - Property damage coverage in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00)
 - Liability coverage in the amount of five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00)
 - **County Property:**
 - Providing for a limit of not less than \$500,000 for all damages arising out of bodily injury or death in any one occurrence
 - Provide for a limit of not less than \$100,000 for all damages arising out of injury to or destruction of property in any one occurrence
 - Subject to that limit per occurrence, an aggregate limit of not less than \$300,000 for all damages arising out of injury to or destruction of property during the policy period
 - Shall include coverage for premises, operations, contractor's protective liability, products, completed operations, and blanket contractual liability
- 3. Provide proof of Workers' Compensation (see details on page 2)
- Be properly registered with the State of Indiana, if applicable (https://inbiz.in.gov/BOS/Home/Index)
- 5. No annual registration fee

	Small Business Enterprise (SBE):

Other individuals can also qualify as socially and economically disadvantaged on a
