USE OF VISITOR PERMITS AND PARKING PERMITS IN RESTRICTED RESIDENTIAL PARKING AREAS

- A residential parking permit may be issued to each licensed driver that resides in a residential zone. Licensed drivers must show proof of residency. If driver's license does not have current address, proof of residency (ie. utility bill, lease, etc.) must be provided. Our office also needs a copy of each vehicle registration.
- Parking permits shall be affixed visibly in the window of your vehicle.
- If a new vehicle is purchased to replace an old vehicle, a new residential parking permit must be obtained.
- Any person parking on the street in a restricted residential parking area must either have a residential parking permit or a valid visitor permit.
- Only two (2) visitor permits will be issued per residence. No replacement permits will be issued if lost or misplaced.
- New visitor permits may be issued every three (3) years. At that time, any visitor permits will be issued for those that have been misplaced or lost.
- Visitor permits may be used while visiting a resident in a restricted residential parking area.
- Visitor permits are only valid for the street shown on the face of the permit.
- Visitor permits may not be duplicated, transferred or altered. Duplicated, transferred or altered visitor permits will not be honored and vehicles will be ticketed and/or towed.
- A visitor permit does not authorize parking in handicapped spaces, in front of yellow or red curbs or driveways, or in any other no-parking areas. Such violations will be dealt with appropriately.
